PROJECT SUMMARY Prince George's Green was a recently launched nonprofit under the fiscal sponsorship of the Alice Ferguson Foundation. Prince George's Green seeks to be a catalyst for the green economy and believe the way to be more inclusive is to focus on green workforce development and green business development.

In 2015, Prince George's Green developed and conducted a Clean Water course held at Prince George's Community College Team Builders Academy. This 10-week course taught students about stormwater issues, stormwater management, and career opportunities in the field.

To connect students with career opportunities and to promote Green Jobs, Prince George's Green held a Green Job fair and

networking event in Hyattsville in spring 2015.

In addition, Prince George's Green conducted Rain Check Rebate outreach to several communities through presentations, newsletters, and community events. Specifically, Prince George's Green organized a Clean Water Day event in Brentwood in summer 2015. Attendees learned more about clean water actions they could take on their own property by participating in a residential water audit that finds opportunities for projects at the site scale, toured a community rain garden to see examples of similar projects they could do, and learned about the Rain Check Rebate program, a program that could financially support efforts they chose to make on their property.
