PROJECT SUMMARY

The Neighborhood Design Center (NDC) received a grant award in 2015 to conduct their Stormwater Savvy program. This program provides design and planning services to communities, resulting in action-oriented design plans that improve water quality while also improving the community's engagement with the landscape.

The plans can then be taken to grantors to request funding and then to professional contractors for implementation.

NDC worked with Dwight D. Eisenhower Middle School; EduCare, Inc.; Eastern Community Church; and Summer Five Homeowner's Association to develop master

plans tailored to each community's needs.

In addition, NDC developed action guides to assist communities in implementing stormwater management practices. These guides include "How Do I Build and Install a Rain Barrel?," "How Do I Plant a Tree?," and "How Do I Build a Rain Garden?" The "How Do I Plant a Tree?" and "How Do I Build a Rain Garden?" action guides were also translated into Spanish for increased accessibility.
