## PROJECT SUMMARY

The Neighborhood Design Center (NDC) received an award in 2015 to provide technical assistance services that support future applicants of the Prince George's Stormwater Stewardship Grant Program.

NDC provided technical services in three key stages: 1. Visioning, 2. Concept Design, and 3. Grant Navigation. These stages cover the initial brainstorming of stormwater practices, conceptual designs of the best fits, and assistance through the grant application process.

NDC worked with a diverse range of groups such as public schools, faith-based

organizations, non-profits, and municipalities. In total, ten Prince George's County groups were engaged in this project. One group, DuVal High School, was awarded a Stormwater Stewardship grant after receiving all three stages of technical assistance.

This project achieved an overarching goal of engaging community leaders in the broader conversation of environmental stewardship. Overall, all participating groups were able to come away with increased knowledge of stormwater management issues and potential solutions.
