PROJECT SUMMARY

In 2015, the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin (ICPRB) was awarded a project to expand the Score Four program to three Prince George's County public schools. This program engages students and teachers in researching stormwater pollution and developing action plans to reduce pollution in their watersheds.

lessons and engaged 407 students and 11 teachers. An additional 56 students and six teachers participated in the implementation or maintenance of three "Student Stormwater Action Projects" (SSAP). These SSAPs included conservation landscaping and a food forest comprised of native fruit and nut-bearing trees and bushes.

ICPRB brought the Score Four program to Northwestern High School, Parkdale High School, and the Academy of Health Sciences in Prince George's County. With the support of numerous partners, ICPRB delivered 48 Score Four

ICPRB is sharing the work done through this grant with other school districts in the Chesapeake Bay watershed and nationally. ICPRB is also translating the Score Four lessons into Spanish to increase the program's reach.
