PROJECT SUMMARY

In 2017, the National Wildlife Federation (NWF) received a grant to provide education to members of faith-based organizations on wildlife habitat creation and stormwater best management practices (BMPs).

Working with partners Interfaith Power and Light MD.DC.NoVA (IPL) and Interfaith Partners of the Chesapeake (IPC), they successfully conducted three Sacred Grounds workshops, reaching 22 congregations and 48 congregants. They also conducted extensive outreach to promote their programs, reaching over 200 places of worship within Prince George's County.

They were able to reinforce the content in their workshop presentations through tours of the host place of worship, identifying opportunities for stormwater BMPs, including rain gardens, rain barrels, and stormwater planters.

The success of this program will be used to model further NWF Sacred Grounds programs throughout the country.
