Qualifications:

Abby Farms is a family-owned nursery and tree farm and producing the highest quality plant material in the Mid-Atlantic region has been our top priority for the past 30 years.

Abby Farms is in Waldorf, MD and has over 1000 acres of farmland producing over 400 varieties of trees and plants. Currently, there are approximately 250,000 units in ground and we're harvesting between 30,000 to 40,000 per year in sizes ranging from 1.5" to 4.5" caliper. Our selection of the best performing varieties of plant material for our area ensures you will not have to worry about cold hardiness or rigorous maintenance to ensure the survival and longevity of your landscape. By harvesting at the proper time and using high quality growing systems to produce a larger more fibrous root system you can expect healthier plants that establish faster and thrive better once installed in your landscape.

The majority of our trees are grown from liners that we've produced or purchased in. Most of our purchased liners come from Oregon and Tennessee but, we also purchase from North Carolina, Georgia, South Carolina, Alabama, and Virginia. All our liners purchased in are planted and harvested no earlier than 3 years from plant date. We also buy in finished material from these same states. The finished material comes in during the fall, winter and spring months and is heeled in mulch to insure survivability. This allows the tree to get acclimated to the area and helps with the survivorship of the tree.

Tree delivery service is offered by Abby Farms. Abby Farms delivers across the Mid-Atlantic, northeast and Midwest areas of the United States. Delivery costs are based on mileage and number of trees on the delivery. Rates are subject to change due to the fluctuation of fuel prices.
