Veterans' Engagement Programs



With Veterans Day just behind us and the season of giving upon us, we at the Chesapeake Bay Trust feel there is no better time to show our gratitude and support of our veterans during their time of recovery, transition and beyond. The Veterans Engagement Mini Grant Program was designed by the Trust to support veterans groups and organizations by providing outdoor activities, green jobs and training, and more. This opportunity seeks to engage veterans and increase the accessibility of healthy natural resources and outdoor experiences with a focus on healing.

Past projects through this program include <u>The 6th Branch</u> which engaged leadership from veterans and provided 7,000 square-feet of green space for youth and the <u>Audubon Naturalist Society of the Central Atlantic States, Inc.</u> which provided green employment training and workshops to benefit 50-75 Maryland veterans.




