CONSERVATION LANDSCAPING – Rebate: \$6/ sq. ft. with soil improvement or \$5/sq. ft. without soil improvement

TREE CANOPY – Rebate: \$150/tree

How many trees do you intend to plant?

PAVEMENT REMOVAL – Rebate: \$6/sq. ft. if replacing with conservation landscaping and \$3/sq. ft. replacing with sod

What is the total area (square feet) of the pavement to be removed?

With what do you intend to replace the pavement?

How will you dispose of the pavement?

PERMEABLE PAVERS – Rebate: \$14/sq. ft.

What is the total area (square feet) of the pavement to be installed?

Will the system include stormwater storage? If yes, how will it discharge stored stormwater?

If you are retrofitting a driveway with permeable pavers, is there a sidewalk present in the project area?*

GREEN ROOFS – Rebate: \$9/sq. ft. (All green roof projects require a stamped structural analysis from a professional engineer.)
